

Progression – Textiles

EYFS

Children learn how to weave with a range of different fabrics

Years 1 & 2

Children learn how to cut out shapes which have been created by drawing round a template onto the fabric. Children begin to sew two fabrics together using a running stitch

Years 3 & 4

Children are able to join fabrics using a range of stitches (Running, over, back) with increasing independence. They learn how to add further decoration to their work using buttons, beads, sequins etc Prototypes are introduced and sewing becomes more accurate.

Years 5 & 6

Children can create products using pattern pieces and demonstrate an awareness of seam allowance. They can pin and tack fabric pieces together and select which stitch is fit for purpose. Children create products with increased accuracy and independence.
